

### 1- Date and location

The Third edition of Takmil will be held in Tunis during the 27th session of the Carthage Film Festival (JCC 2016) on November 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> 2016.

## 2- Objectives

The Carthage Film Festival wishes to allow African and Arab filmmakers to submit their films in the stage of post-production to the expertise of an International Jury. And to provide material assistance to the completion of African and Arab films offering post-production grants presented by the Festival partners.

### 3- The Grants

The grants will be awarded at the end of the workshop.

## 4- Description of the workshop

Takmil will last 3 days (November  $1^{st}$ ,  $2^{nd}$  and  $3^{rd}$ ) during which the director or the producer will be invited to defend and debate his/her film in front of the jurors.

## 5- Eligibility criteria

The films presented must be in post-production and their directors must be from African and Arab countries. Are eligible feature fictions or feature art-house documentaries of minimum 60 minute- final length. Rough cuts must be of a minimum of 30 minute- length.

Copies submitted must be subtitled in English.

A director can only participate with one project.

A producer can participate with maximum two projects.

### 6- Selection Process

The selection results will be communicated to the directors before the 30th September 2016.

# 7- Registration of Films:

### Dead line 1st September, 2016

In order to be considered for selection, applicants must:

- Fill out the "Takmil" submission form,
- Send the Festival two copies of the film (accepted formats: DVD, Blu-ray disc).

### 8- Selected Films:

Films guests will receive a notification on the 15th September 2016.

- a) The selection of a film must remain confidential until the official announcement of the Festival.
- b) The full cost of sending the material, including customs expenses to the Festival headquarters, will be borne by the applicant.

## 9- Participant Invitations

The Carthage Film Festival will cover trip expenses and accommodations for the selected director or producer for three days.

### 10- Academy awards

The winning film must include "With the support of Takmil" with Carthage Film Festival logo in the credits and in any documents related to the film.

The first Arab screening must be reserved for The Carthage Film Festival.

### 11-General Rule

Participation in the Takmil workshop constitutes unconditional adherence to these Regulations. The direction of the festival reserves the right to settle any case not covered by these Regulations, and to waive the Regulations in special and well-motivated instances.
