

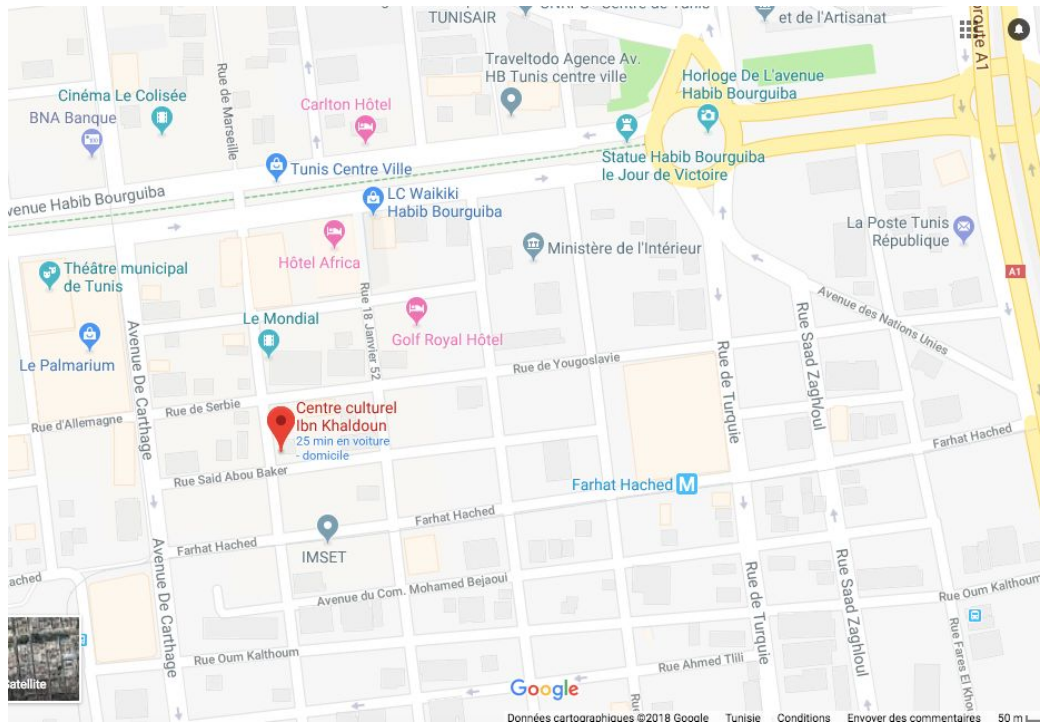


MEDIA GUIDE

Welcome to all our friends from the media

Accreditation / Information:

Journalists and media accredited to the Carthage Film Festival 2018 can pick up their working documents at the International Media Center located at the Maison de la Culture Ibn Khaldoun Tunis, 2nd floor. (see map)



The MEDIA badge, which includes your photo, your full name, gives you access to the Media Center, press briefings, panels and conferences as well as cinemas (tickets to access the media screenings of your choice are available free of charge for journalists at the Media Center and can be picked up, up to 48 hours in advance). It to book your tickets for screenings in advance to limited availability of seats dedicated to the media.

We ask you to wear your badge in all areas of the festival perishes at all times.

The press office is located at the Maison de la Culture Ibn Khaldoun, 16 Ibn Khaldoun Street (behind Hotel Africa) and is open to accredited media for the duration of the Festival, daily from 9am to 8pm and is only accessible to professionals wearing media badges.

The Media Center is a friendly coworking space made available to journalists, covering the festival. It is also a space dedicated to press briefings, meetings and interviews.

The media center shall not assume any responsibility for the loss of any personal belongings.

Requests for interviews:

Whenever possible, the Media Center and its team can facilitate meeting requests with festival representatives, actors, directors, talents and other professional guests.

You can request an interview by completing the interview request form sent to you via Email. This form is also available at the Media Center Press Office.

In order to respect the press deadlines, we kindly ask you to make the requests at least 24hours in advance and we promise to do our best to attend to all requests. However, confirmation will depend on the availability of the potential interviewee.

Please note that all interviews arranged by the press office will take place at the media center.

One week before the opening, the press office will provide all the media professionals with a list of guests attending the festival.

Red carpet, access & procedures:

Access to the red carpet for photographers, cameraman and journalist / interviewer, for the opening and closing ceremonies, is only possible with a special "Red Carpet" badge.

Requests for access to the red carpet must be made by journalists and media no later than October 31, 2018 at midnight through email to the following address redcarpet@jctunisie.org

Access to the red carpet is limited and the "RED CARPET" badge is valid only for the opening and closing ceremony. Wearing the badge is compulsory at all times.

Please check the press office if you have received a spot on the red carpet for the opening and closing ceremonies.

Every journalist with access to the red carpet must be at the back entrance of the Cité de la Culture, **between 4pm and 5pm** for opening and **between 6:30 pm and 7:30 pm** for the closing. Please note that latecomers will not be admitted for security reasons.

The RED CARPET badge does not give access to the Opera House and the opening and closing ceremonies which are accessed by invitation only.

During the opening and closing ceremonies, all types of audio-visual recording and photographs are not allowed inside the Opera House, the Tunisian National television, partner of the JCC, has the exclusive rights to the images of both galas.

However, the JCC will provide to all accredited media, a complete recording of the two ceremonies with images containing no logo.

Important: No cameras or video cameras will be allowed inside the Opera House during the Opening and Closing Ceremonies

Dress Code:

The official dress code for the opening and closing ceremonies is evening attire.

Audiovisual content:

This year, the JCC and its audio-visual teams will provide all accredited media daily rushes of 30 minutes as well as branded or unbranded one to two minute capsules (available on Wettransfer link). The entire team of the press office remains at your disposal for any further inquiries.

Public Screening Tickets: Media Privileges

The media badge allows its holder from accredited media to acquire free tickets to screenings, available at the media center. it is to be noted that there is a quota for the daily tickets dedicated to media and can be collected from the media office from 9am to 6pm. The center will only have tickets for the same day and the follow day screenings.

The festival teams, and particularly the media center team, shall spare no effort to make your work easier.
